

Approval of ISPM 15-marking at Herrljunga Emballage AB

The Swedish Board of Agriculture approves that Herrljunga Emballage AB may use the mark below on their production of wood packaging made from debarked wood that has been heat treated by kiln drying.



The company's official registration number at the Swedish Board of Agriculture is SE-P3401.

The conditions for approval are given in the Swedish Regulation (SJVFS 2004:53) on heat treatment, drying and marking of sawn wood products, wood packaging materials etc. This approval means that the company's production of wood packaging material fulfils the requirements of treatment and marking laid down in the FAO standard ISPM 15.

The approval has no time limit, but may be withdrawn if an inspection by the Board of Agriculture finds that the company no longer fulfils the requirements. If the approval is withdrawn, the above marking may no longer be used.
